Student Athlete Achievement Award - Girls and Boys Basketball, Football and Wrestling

Basketball: Iowa Bankers Association will provide and present the Student Athlete Achievement Award, along with a \$1,000 college scholarship, to a student athlete selected by an independent panel at the beginning of tournament week. Teams qualifying for the state tournament may nominate one senior for the award. A winner will be selected from each of the four classes (1A, 2A, 3A, 4A) and awards will be presented after each championship game at the state tournaments. An Iowa banker from the student's hometown will present the award and deliver the award plaque to the school for display in their trophy case. The presentations will be aired live during television and radio broadcasts.

Football: Iowa Bankers Association will provide and present the Student Athlete Achievement Award, along with a \$1,000 college scholarship, to a student athlete selected by an independent panel. Teams qualifying for the state quarterfinals may nominate one senior for the award. A winner will be selected from each of the six classes (8-player, A, 1A, 2A, 3A, 4A). The awards presentation will be filmed prior to the start of each game and broadcast before kickoff of each championship game at the state tournament. The presentation will also be aired to the UNI-Dome audience in attendance during the first quarter of each championship game. An Iowa banker from the student's hometown will present the award and deliver the award plaque to the school for display in their trophy case. The presentations will be aired live during television and radio broadcasts.

Wrestling: Iowa Bankers Association will provide and present the Student Athlete Achievement Award, along with a \$1,000 college scholarship, to a student athlete selected by an independent panel at the beginning of tournament week. Senior wrestlers qualifying for the state tournament may be nominated for the award. One winner will be selected and presented with the award prior to the start of the championship matches. An Iowa banker from the student's hometown will present the award and deliver the award plaque to the school for display in their trophy case. The presentations will be aired live during television and radio broadcasts.
